Infrared Sauna

Ideal for those who are heat-sensitive, our infrared sauna helps relieve sore muscles and improves overall health and well-being. Just 20 minutes a day can result in better sleep, weight loss, pain relief, clearer skin and improved circulation.

Traditional Sauna

The benefits of a team sauna are many, from clearing congestion and lowering blood pressure to easing joint stiffness, muscle pains and promoting relaxation.

Steam Room

Our steam room is heated with a specially-designed steam generator. The humidity from the steam comes with myriad health benefits such as clearing congestion, improving skin health, lowering blood pressure, improving circulation, workout recovery, relaxation, and easing joint stiffness.

Warm Plunge Pool

Hot water is used in holistic therapies to relax joints, ease muscle tension, reduce pain, stimulate blood circulation and promote relaxation. The water in the warm plunge pool is heated up to 40 degrees Celsius.

Cold Plunge Pool

Cold water is used to improve blood circulation, improve sleep, increase energy levels, reduce inflammation, control anxiety, remove fatty deposits and speed up the metabolic rate. Contrast therapy can be used to treat injury and pain. The water in the cold plunge pool is cooled to 5-10 degrees Celsius.

Health Suite

The Bali Eden caters to all of our guest's needs including providing a safe environment where the process of healing is prioritised as the path to ultimate wellness, offering a wide range of healing treatments including:

Cryotherapy

Cryotherapy, also known as 'cold therapy' is the use of extreme cold to treat a variety of health issues. The body is exposed to ultra-low temperatures between negative 90°C-150°C between two and four minutes. It provides a whole host of benefits including reducing inflammation,





accelerating recovery, anti-ageing, increasing energy levels and rejuvenating the body.

• IV Drips

The fastest and most efficient way possible to deliver nutrients to the body for the purpose of hydration, health and wellness. Your body will receive vitamins and nutrients directly into the bloodstream. Benefits include boosting your immune system, increased hydration levels, lower oxidative stress, slowing the ageing process, boosting energy levels, combating fatigue and accelerating wound healing. IV Therapy can also improve the overall health and appearance of your skin, hair, and nails, reduce wrinkles, repair UV damage, and brighten the skin.

• Colonic Hydrotherapy

Colonic Hydrotherapy is a colon cleansing process that uses a gentle flow of filtered water to flush out toxic waste and excess gases, while re-hydrating a constipated bowel. Flushing the colon removes faecal matter, gas and mucus, for a healthy gut. This will allow nutrients to be easily absorbed and can boost energy and enhance the body's immune system.

• Live 02

The simplest and fastest way to send large amounts of oxygen into the cells. Experience breathing high levels of oxygen while exercising. When oxygen levels are increased, waste gases and toxins are removed more efficiently and cells begin to function at optimum levels.

Salt Therapy

Spend some time in our salt cabin to clean your respiratory systems and lungs effectively. This can help to reduce sneezing, coughing, and shortness of breath, while nourishing and revitalizing the skin. Seats up to 8 people max.

Meditation Class

Practice moving meditation in the hot yoga room or simply sit in silence and meditate to the sound of the jungle and the river as it passes by. Classes are complimentary and are held every day from 14:00 - 15:00.

Balinese Dancing Yoga Lesson

A unique exercise, combining Balinese dance movements with yoga poses and techniques to still the mind, strengthen the body and expand the consciousness with posture, breath work, meditation and relaxation. Classes are conducted by an experienced instructor and are suitable for beginners.

Melali ke Banjar

Melali means "taking a leisurely walk" or "heading out" for a specific reason. Banjar is the village council that governs each local village. All Balinese in every village must participate in Banjar activities, especially when there is a meeting or a large ceremony to be held. Guests participating in this activity can interact and observe the local villagers as they go about their tasks while learning all about the Balinese way of life.

Traditional Hat Making

The traditional Balinese hat usually worn by Balinese farmers is called capil. Made from coconut leaves, these hats are unique and functional, and are really easy to make. Make your own to take home with you at our Traditional Hat Making Class.

Herbology Class

Have you ever wondered which herbs and spices give Balinese cuisine its exquisitely unique, exotic and distinct taste? Guests can join our herbology class to get to know the island's rich treasure trove of herbs and spices.

Making Loloh

Learn the ancient art of making Loloh, a traditional Balinese healing elixir used to treat everyday ailments such as coughs and colds, chills and body aches, headaches, stomach issues and more. All-natural ingredients such as herbs, spices, roots, fruits and flowers are muddled, squeezed and stirred to create a herbal remedy. A famous variety is "Loloh Cemcem", traditionally used to treat digestive and gut issues.





Making Canang Sari

Made from coconut leaf, betel nut, and lime, their base symbolizes three powers: creation, preservation, and unity. Flowers symbolize peace and tranquillity. The flower arrangement is sorted by color and meaning. The canang sari represents a symbol to demonstrate gratitude.

Balinese Dancing

The perfect complement to their Bali holiday, guests can experience dancing at the local Banjar alongside local Balinese children from the surrounding villages. This is an authentic experience – Balinese children have been attending traditional dance classes at their local Banjar for centuries, learning the intricate art of dance from the village's best dancer / instructor.

Shuttle to Ubud

DESTINATION

The town of Ubud, in the uplands of Bali, Indonesia, is known as Bali's spiritual and cultural hub. The surrounding jungle and terraced rice paddies, dotted with Hindu temples and shrines, are among some of Bali's most famous landscapes. Ancient holy sites include the mysterious Goa Gajah ("Elephant Cave") and Gunung Kawi, home to a collection of ancient "candi" or shrines carved directly into the face of the rock cliff. Mas is a village about six km south of Ubud – known for its wood carvings. Mas is also the home of the renowned Nyana & Tilem Gallery and the birthplace of the famous mask carver, Ida Bagus Sutarja.
